The answer is two-fold: (1) stop relying on tests that don't work (this course of action would be appropriate even if there were no alternatives to animal testing); and (2) rely instead on numerous recently developed testing techniques and diagnostic methods, all focused on humans rather than animals, including in vitro testing of human cells
