### Explorations in Social Theory

If the study of politics is to be rewarding both intellectually and practically it must, by definition, concern itself with the great issues which arise in the real world and with the fundamental arguments which occur about their nature and the possible solutions to them. Abstract political philosophy which is not informed by the experience of practice will become sterile. A study of constitutions and the machinery of government can become dry-as-dust and hence boring unless the underlying principles are analysed and grasped. But theories of political change divorced from an understanding of constitutions and institutions will degenerate into mere phrase-mongering. Attempts to apply the techniques of the natural sciences to politics will lead to model building for its own sake and thence to arid and barren intellectualism unless it is understood that it is impossible to quantify the intangible. Indeed, any one-sided approach to politics and consequent failure to grasp the essential wholeness of the subject is bound to end in disaster. The study of politics is a study of changing human relationships in dynamic societies. Thus it involves, since the present and hence the future are shaped in part by the past, an appreciation of history.

### Agricultural Involution

Karena itu, perlulah diteliti dan diuraikan bagaimana wujud dan corak kritik sastra Indonesia modern sejak timbulnya hingga sekarang; diteliti secara teliti dan saksama demi perkembangan ilmu sastra Indonesia modern khususnya dan ilmu sastra Indonesia pada umumnya. Penelitian kritik sastra Indonesia modern ini perlu dilakukan mengingat tulisan-tulisan atau referensi yang dapat digolongkan dalam penelitian kritik sastra Indonesia modern belumlah memadai.

However, the exposition of the theory of social classes and class conflict stands in the center of this investigation. The resume of Marx's theory of class, the largely descriptive account of some historical changes of the past century, and the critical examination of some earlier theories of class, including that of Marx, lead up to the central theoretical chapters; with the analysis of post-capitalist society in terms of class theory a first empirical test of my theoretical position is intended. An innovator in contemporary thought on economic and political development looks here at decline rather than growth. Albert O. Hirschman makes a basic distinction between alternative ways of reacting to deterioration in business firms and, in general, to dissatisfaction with organizations: one, "exit," is for the member to quit the organization or for the customer to switch to the competing product, and the other, "voice," is for members or customers to agitate and exert influence for change "from within." The efficiency of the competitive mechanism, with its total reliance on exit, is questioned for certain important situations. As exit often undercuts voice while being

unable to counteract decline, loyalty is seen in the function of retarding exit and of permitting voice to play its proper role. The interplay of the three concepts turns out to illuminate a wide range of economic, social, and political phenomena. As the author states in the preface, "having found my own unifying way of looking at issues as diverse as competition and the two-party system, divorce and the American character, black power and the failure of 'unhappy' top officials to resign over Vietnam, I decided to let myself go a little."

In his landmark study of exchange and power in social life, Peter M. Blau contributes to an understanding of social structure by analyzing the social processes that govern the relations between individuals and groups. The basic question that Blau considers is: How does social life become organized into increasingly complex structures of associations among humans. This analysis, first published in 1964, represents a pioneering contribution to the sociological literature. Blau uses concepts of exchange, reciprocity, imbalance, and power to examine social life and to derive the more complex processes in social structure from the simpler ones. The principles of reciprocity and imbalance are used to derive such processes as power, changes in group structure; and the two major forces that govern the dynamics of complex social structures: the legitimization of organizing authority of increasing scope and the emergence of oppositions along different lines producing conflict and change.
