He must make contact with his heir Corranra, a lesbian, with the use of her twenty-three year old navel cord. In addition, Chiezne, a spiritual seed imprisoned to Earth for 500 years during the demise of the Lucayan Indians needs her so that he could return to the heavens. Corranra has no interests in Obeah. She is a Junkanoo-festival drummer-dancer and photographer. Sasha, a neophyte pesters her, but Corranra's puppy love, Morganna, returns from Germany. Wit and Humor The Oxford Handbook of Andrew Marvell is the most comprehensive and informative collection of essays ever assembled dealing with the life and writings of the poet and politician Andrew Marvell (1621-78). Like his friend and colleague John Milton, Marvell is now seen as a dominant figure in the literary landscape of the mid-seventeenth century, producing a stunning oeuvre of poetry and prose either side of the Restoration. In the 1640s and 1650s he was the author of hypercanonical lyrics like 'To His Coy Mistress' and 'The Garden' as well as three epoch-defining poems about Oliver Cromwell. After 1660 he virtually invented the verse genre of state satire as well as becoming the most influential prose satirist of the day—in the process forging a long-lived reputation as an incorruptible patriot. Although Marvell himself was an intensely private and self-contained character, whose literary, religious, and political commitments are notoriously difficult to discern, the interdisciplinary contributions by an array of experts in the fields of seventeenth-century literature, history, and politics gathered together in the Handbook constitute a decisive step forward in our understanding of him. They offer a fully-rounded account of his life and writings, individual readings of his key works, considerations of his relations with his major contemporaries, and surveys of his rich and varied afterlives. Informed by the wealth of editorial and biographical work on Marvell that has been produced in the last twenty years, the volume is both a conspectus of the state of the art in Marvell studies and the springboard for future research.

The Story of Our Services Under the Crown During the Nazi occupation of Budapest, András, a young Jewish music student, is sent to a forced labor camp. András recognizes her and they fall deeply in love, his cassock no longer able to protect his identity. Shortly after, the Russians arrive and András is again sent to a forced labor camp. During his absence from Budapest, Marianna is chased into a destroyed church by Russians, where she is killed in a fall from the tower. András returns to find her mangled corpse, vowing that the only way he and Marianna will be together is in death.
